It was a relatively quiet seismic week as the number of earthquakes declined by more than half and fell below the 10 quakeper-week mark. It was the fewest number in 19 weeks and only the second singledigit tally this year.

The intensity of seismicity relaxed as well as no activity registered M 2.0 or stronger. This is strike contrast to last week when five quakes measured M 2.0 or stronger, including a pair of M 3s.
Two more quakes occurred southwest of Only two quakes were recorded north of Quincy, a M 1.2 near Spring Garden and a M 1.6 on the Battle Creek Fault Zone near the Shasta-Tehama County line.
