Dear Mr. White,

This letter is a follow up of the inspection I made of your property on Friday November 21, 2008. As we discussed while I was there, there are a number of code violations. I am of course well aware that you have applied for a use permit. The application however is still not complete. The following is a list of the code violations:

- 1. Violation Grading without a permit
 - a) Requirement to abate Issuance of Use Permit will abate this violation but if Use Permit is not approved then a grading permit will be required.
- 2. Violation No Use Permit
 - a) Requirement to abate Finish application submittal within 30 days. Then follow through to final permit issuance.
- 3. Violation Living in Travel Trailers
 - a) Requirement to abate Stop occupancy of trailers and remove them from the property or obtain a Use Permit for security housing and/or employee housing - within 30 days
- 4. Violation Brushing more than 10,000 sq. ft. without a permit
 - a) Requirement to abate Issuance of Use Permit will abate this violation but if Use Permit is not approved then a brushing permit will be required.
- 8. Violation Retaining walls built without permits
 - a) Requirement to abate Obtain building permit, must apply within 30 days
- 6. Violation Improper Sewage Disposal
 - a) Requirement to abate Remove need for sewage disposal or apply for and obtain all appropriate permits for a septic system - Within 30 days.
- 7. Violation Electrical wiring installed without permits
- a) Requirement to abate Obtain permit within 30 days. Before wiring 1 tanted

All violations must be abated to bring the property into compliance. You will have to contact the appropriate County Departments for the actual permitting requirements. IE: Building, Planning & Environmental Health.

The only work you are authorized to do at this time is erosion control work. All other work must cease until the required permits are issued.
