Re: Securing of Hazardous Abandoned Mine Feature(s)

Dear Claimant/Property Owner:

The Division of Minerals' Abandoned Mine Lands Program is continuing its legislatively-mandated task of discovering dangerous conditions that result from mining practices that took place at mines that are no longer in operation. Generally, after the discovery of an unsecured dangerous condition, the claimant/owner is notified by the Division that it is their responsibility to secure the hazard. However, when the Division determines that the hazard represents an imminent public safety risk, the Division may proactively secure the hazard prior to formal notification to the claimant/owner or the occurrence of any securing efforts by the claimant/owner, or when a previously secured site is found in disrepair.

Recently, Division staff, its contractor(s) or volunteers working on behalf of the Division *have* secured one or more hazards on land believed to be on your claim or parcel. This effort was performed solely to protect the public from imminent physical safety hazard(s).

This letter is intended to provide you with notice of these efforts and serves as a reminder that if the hazard(s) are on your active claim or private parcel, then any maintenance or future securing work is your responsibility.

Enclosed please find a copy of our hazard inventory sheet(s) detailing the location and description of the hazard(s) and securing status. If you have any questions regarding the hazard(s) or the recent work, please do not hesitate to contact this office.


